ORDINANCE NO. 179

An Ordinance to prohibit persons from placing snow, ice, slush, dirt or debris on public property:

THE CITY OF BRIDGMAN ORDAINS

Section 1. Purpose.

This Chapter is declared necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the people of the City of Bridgman, and is intended to prevent persons and businesses from removing snow, slush, ice, dirt or debris from private property and placing it on public property, to the detriment of the general public.

Section 2. Definitions and Interpretation.

All of the terms in this Ordinance shall be given their regular and ordinary meanings. Said Ordinance shall be interpreted to prohibit the placement of slush, snow, ice, dirt or debris on public property to the greatest degree possible.

Section 3. Placement of Slush, Snow, Ice, Dirt or Debris onto Public Property Prohibited.

No person shall remove any slush, snow, ice, dirt or debris from privately-owned real property and place it upon any sidewalk, street or other public property in a manner that prevents the public from traversing or in any way utilizing any sidewalk, street, or other public property within the City of Bridgman.

Section 4. Penalty

A violation of this Ordinance shall be a civil infraction with a fine of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for the first violation and Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for any second or subsequent violation.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances

All other ordinances of the City of Bridgman, to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
